

Division 35: Disability Services Commission —

Question: Mr D.J. Kelly asked: When did the Disability Services Commission or the government make a decision about the two preferred disability justice centre sites?

Answer:

The selection of sites for the disability justice centres was a Cabinet decision. Cabinet made this decision on 4 June 2013.

The Planning Commission documents that the honourable member referred to, dated 26 April 2013, reflect that prior to seeking a Cabinet Decision, government departments routinely scope and prepare recommendations to put to their Ministers and to Cabinet. The documents of 26 April show that, as expected, planning, preparation and recommendations about the sites for the disability justices centres were being developed. This planning activity is not, however, a government decision regarding the sites. The very act of taking the matter to Cabinet demonstrates that the Disability Services Commission, and the Minister for Disability Services, were conscious of the decision not being theirs alone to make.

\$23.0m in 2010–11;
\$30.0m in 2011–12 ;
\$34.9m in 2012-13; and

Answer: The number of labour hire staff within the Accommodation Services as at 20 May 2014 was 108.

Question: Dr A.D. Buti asked: How many staff vacancies existed in the department as at 1 May 2014? What are the vacant positions and where are they located? How many of those positions will not be filled until after 1 July 2014?

Answer:

As at 1 May 2014 there were 208.67 FTE vacant positions across the Disability Services Commission. These include both full-time and part-time positions. This is not atypical. These vacancies are managed through a range of strategies including overtime, contract employees, agency staff and internal acting opportunities.
