

ROAD TRAFFIC (CONSEQUENTIAL PROVISIONS) BILL 2007

Receipt and First Reading

Bill received from the Assembly; and, on motion by **Hon Adele Farina (Parliamentary Secretary)**, read a first time.

Second Reading

HON ADELE FARINA (South West — Parliamentary Secretary) [5.03 pm]: I move —

That the bill be now read a second time.

This is one of a suite of five bills to facilitate the introduction of the Road Transport Reform (Compliance and Enforcement) Bill national reforms and to realign Western Australia's road traffic legislation based on administrative and functional responsibilities. The Road Traffic (Consequential Provisions) Bill repeals and deletes the various clauses of the Road Traffic Act 1974 that have been moved to the new bills and provides for the amendment of all other legislation impacted upon by these changes. This bill does not introduce any new legislative provisions into Western Australian law, but simply facilitates the proposed new road traffic legislative structure. I commend the bill to the house.

Discharge of Order and Referral to the Standing Committee on Uniform Legislation and Statutes Review

On motion without notice by **Hon Kim Chance (Leader of the House)**, resolved —

That the Road Traffic (Consequential Provisions) Bill 2007 be discharged and referred to the Standing Committee on Uniform Legislation and Statutes Review for consideration and report not later than 6 May 2008.
