Petition

MR D.A. TEMPLEMAN (Mandurah) [12.02 pm]: I have a petition to the house couched in the following terms —

To the Honourable Speaker and Members of the Legislative Assembly of the Parliament of Western Australia in Parliament assembled.

We the undersigned express our outrage that the Government proposes to cut funding to public libraries in Western Australia.

Public Libraries are essential community services that provide a range of opportunities for people of all ages.

We call upon the Legislative Assembly to ensure that the Government does not cut funding to Western Australian libraries.
