

**SMARTRIDER TERMINAL — KELMSCOTT NEWSAGENCY**

*Petition*

**DR A.D. BUTI (Armadale)** [12.10 pm]: I have a petition with 339 signatures that accords with proper procedures. It states —

To the Honourable the Speaker and Members of the Legislative Assembly of the Parliament of Western Australia in Parliament assembled.

We, the undersigned, request that the Barnett Government provide a Smart Rider terminal at the Kelmscott Newsagency, situated at the Kelmscott Village Shopping Centre 2883–2889 Albany Highway Kelmscott.

The closest terminal to the Kelmscott Newsagency is approximately 800 meters away, on the other side of Albany Highway. The Kelmscott Newsagency is on the same side of the Albany Highway as the Kelmscott Train Station. Crossing an extremely busy highway is a serious safety hazard for those needing to update their smart rider card. Public transport is used frequently by the elderly and school age children and they should not have to encounter grave risks to purchase or upgrade the status of a travel card.
