New Clause 33A

Page 21, after line 17 — To insert —

## 33A. Review of Act

- (1) The Minister must carry out a review of the operation and effectiveness of this Act as soon as is practicable after the 3<sup>rd</sup> anniversary of the day on which this section comes into operation.
- (2) The Minister must prepare a report based on the review and, as soon as is practicable after the report is prepared, cause it to be laid before each House of Parliament.

## Mr J.R. QUIGLEY: I move —

That the amendment made by the Council be agreed to.

**Dr M.D. NAHAN**: It is my understanding that this amendment was decided in the upper house, consistent with some national processes. Perhaps the Attorney General could describe that. If so, we will of course agree with it.

**Mr J.R. QUIGLEY**: This amendment was moved and passed in the upper house to include a review clause for the Domestic Violence Orders (National Recognition) Bill 2017 on the third anniversary.

Question put and passed; the Council's amendment agreed to.
