

APPROPRIATION (CONSOLIDATED ACCOUNT) BILL (NO. 1) 2007

Receipt and First Reading

Bill received from the Assembly; and, on motion by **Hon Kate Doust (Parliamentary Secretary)**, read a first time.

Second Reading

HON KATE DOUST (South Metropolitan - Parliamentary Secretary) [4.50 pm]: I move -

That the bill be now read a second time.

The purpose of this bill is to grant supply and to appropriate sums from the consolidated account required for the recurrent services and purposes for the 2007-08 financial year as detailed in the consolidated account agency information in support of the estimates. Total expenditure is estimated to be \$13 069 709 000 of which \$1 277 935 000 is permanently appropriated under special acts, leaving an amount of \$11 791 774 000, which is to be appropriated to the services and purposes identified in the schedule to this bill. I commend the bill to the house.
