

**APPROPRIATION (CONSOLIDATED ACCOUNT) RECURRENT 2010–11 BILL 2010**

*Receipt and First Reading*

Bill received from the Assembly; and, on motion by **Hon Norman Moore (Leader of the House)**, read a first time.

*Second Reading*

**HON NORMAN MOORE (Mining and Pastoral — Leader of the House)** [6.02 pm]: I move —

That the bill be now read a second time.

The purpose of this bill is to grant supply and to appropriate sums from the consolidated account required for the recurrent services and purposes for the 2010–11 financial year as detailed in the consolidated account agency information in support of the estimates. Total expenditure is estimated to be \$17 577 494 000 of which \$1 550 072 000 is permanently appropriated under special acts, leaving an amount of \$16 027 422 000, which is to be appropriated to the services and purposes identified in the schedule to this bill. I commend the bill to the house.
