

SHIRE OF CUE COUNCIL — INQUIRY

Petition

MR D.A. TEMPLEMAN (Mandurah) [9.01 am]: I have a petition couched in the following terms —

To the Honourable the Speaker and Members of the Legislative Assembly of the Parliament of Western Australia in Parliament assembled.

We the undersigned, say

the ratepayers of the Shire of Cue have lost all confidence and faith in the administration and Council of the Shire of Cue to consider the views of, and to make decisions for the benefit of the majority of ratepayers of the Shire. Ratepayers have submitted a number of matters which they consider indicate the intractability of the administration or the Council to properly consider the views of ratepayers. Moreover, some ratepayers consider that the response of the administration or Council to their individual issues could be construed as victimisation

Now we ask the Legislative Assembly

- 1 To carry out an investigation of the activities and practices of the Shire administration and review the decision making process and activities of the Council.
- 2 We also request that in carrying out such an investigation that members of the community are interviewed and their complaints recorded and that any investigation is not restricted to the self-preserving comments or defences from the administration and elected Councillors

The petition has been certified as complying with the standing orders and contains 17 signatures.
