

LAKELANDS HIGH SCHOOL — STATUS

1943. Mr D.A. Templeman to the Minister representing the Minister for Education:

I refer to the state secondary school sector in Mandurah and ask:

- (a) what is the status of the proposed Lakelands High School in the locality of Lakelands, north of Mandurah;
- (b) has planning for this school commenced and if so what is the expected timeline for this school's build and opening year;
- (c) what years are proposed to be accommodated at Lakelands High School; and
- (d) is a designated Education Support School being proposed for a high school in Lakelands?

Mr J.H.D. Day replied:

- (a)–(b) Master planning for the proposed Lakelands High School site and the abutting district open space is progressing with the City of Mandurah. The Department of Education has commenced discussions with the developer, Peet and Co., for the acquisition of a 6.7 ha portion of the school site.

The Department of Education, in association with the Department of Finance — Building Management and Works, is preparing a business case. The timing for the school's construction or opening year is yet to be announced and is subject to the budget process.

- (c) Years 7 to 12.
- (d) It is proposed to include facilities for students with special needs as part of the proposed Lakelands High School.
