I refer to the \$20 million roof top bar and entertainment area planned for the Art Gallery of WA, and ask:

- (a) have two American artists been commissioned to deliver works for the new facility:

 - (ii) please list the artworks those artists will provide for the facility and the costs for each;
- (b) have any other overseas artists been commissioned to provide artworks for the facility:

- (c) will the costs of the artwork be met by the \$2.5 million grant provided by the State Government through the TomorrowFund:

- (d) are any Aboriginal artists involved in the provision of artworks for the rooftop facility:

- (f) when were the decisions made regarding the provision of the artworks for the facility; and
- (g) why has there been no public consultation or competitions conducted for the provision of the artworks?
