

LIQUOR LICENSING APPLICATIONS

8249. Dr A.D. Buti to the Minister for Racing and Gaming

In relation to the costs of determining liquor licensing applications, for each of the years 2009–2010, 2010–2011 and 2011–2012:

- (a) how many applications were there;
- (b) how many applications cost less than \$200;
- (c) how many applications cost \$425 or less;
- (d) how many applications cost more than \$425;
- (e) how many applications cost between \$425 and \$1,000;
- (f) how many applications cost between \$1,000 and \$2,000;
- (g) how many applications cost between \$2,000 and \$3,000; and
- (h) how many applications cost more than \$3,000?

- (a) 2009–2010 7,999
2010–2011 10,640
2011–2012 10,870
- (b)–(h) The Department of Racing, Gaming and Liquor does not hold the information necessary to cost individual applications in the manner proposed by the question and is therefore not able to provide the information requested.
