

CITY OF PERTH — INQUIRY

3952. Mr A. Krsticevic to the Minister for Local Government:

I refer to the inquiry into the Perth City Council, and ask:

- (a) What infrastructure measures have been put in place, including:
 - (i) Office space;
 - (ii) Cars or other vehicles, either leased or purchased, for inquiry team and is the vehicle or vehicles dedicated to the inquiry team;
 - (iii) Number of staff; and
 - (iv) Stationery supplies; and
- (b) What is the cost of the infrastructure measures for:
 - (i) Office space;
 - (ii) Cars or other vehicles, either leased or purchased, for inquiry team and is the vehicle or vehicles dedicated to the inquiry team;
 - (iii) Number of staff; and
 - (iv) Stationery supplies?

Mr D.A. Templeman replied:

- (a)
 - (i) The Panel of Inquiry are located at 111 St Georges' Terrace, utilising vacant space at WAIRC.
 - (ii) Not applicable.
 - (iii) Currently 11 staff (including Inquirer).
 - (iv) Stationery supplies are sourced as required.
- (b) The overall budget for the Panel of Inquiry is \$2.4m and the costs for (i–iv) are allocated within that.
