Question: Mr J.N. Hyde asked: Is the minister able to provide by supplementary information what exactly the 33 heritage-listed buildings are and what their current maintenance needs and challenges are, with the expected costings?

Answer: The Culture and the Arts buildings with heritage-listed status are shown below. This includes newer buildings within a heritage precinct that have heritage obligations.

The expected full cost of maintenance in 2012-2013 for these buildings is yet to be determined as each requires an extensive and specialist building condition assessment (BCA) which will take some years to complete across the portfolio. Currently repairs and maintenance are conducted as the need arises however the Department intends to have a longer term maintenance plan developed over the next few years as the BCAs are completed for each site.
