

HON PAUL BROWN — VEHICLE SIGNAGE

649. Mr D.A. TEMPLEMAN to the Leader of the National Party:

Before I ask my question I would like to acknowledge the teachers and year 6 students from Riverside Primary School in Mandurah, who dined with me today; they are wonderful.
