- (b) total mobile device (i.e. iPad) data expenditure; and
- (c) total credit card expenditure?

Former Department of Local Government and Communities (including the Office of Multicultural Interests)

For the period 1 January 2017 to 30 June 2017

- (a)–(b) \$60 791.41 on mobile phone and mobile data usage.
- (c) The total cost of administering credit cards is \$0 as it is under the CUA purchasing card agreement with the NAB through the Department of Finance.

Former Department of Culture and the Arts

For the period 1 January 2017 to 30 June 2017

- (a)–(b) \$14 658.34 on mobile phone and mobile data usage.
