

BUS ROUTE 352 — MADELEY

Petition

MS M.M. QUIRK (Girrawheen) [12.01 pm]: I have a petition signed by 136 petitioners that complies with the standing orders and reads as follows —

To the Honourable the Speaker and Members of the Legislative Assembly of the Parliament of Western Australia in Parliament assembled.

We, the undersigned, say that plans to reroute the 352 bus route next year will mean that it no longer deviates along Regency Avenue in Madeley should be reconsidered.

This change in particular will mean that the many seniors who live on or around Regency Avenue will have further to walk and reduced access to public transport. It may also have the effect of fewer seniors engaging in volunteering, other social activities or using public transport to get to medical appointments.

Now we ask the Legislative Assembly to consider a review of this proposal and the retention of the existing route 352 which includes bus stops in Regency Avenue.

Your petitioners therefore humbly pray that you will give this matter earnest consideration and your petitioners, as in duty bound, will ever pray.
