

ROAD TRAFFIC (CONSEQUENTIAL PROVISIONS) BILL 2007

Introduction and First Reading

Bill introduced, on motion by **Ms A.J.G. MacTiernan (Minister for Planning and Infrastructure)**, and read a first time.

Explanatory memorandum presented by the minister.

Second Reading

MS A.J.G. MacTIERNAN (Armadale - Minister for Planning and Infrastructure) [12.49 pm]: I move -

That the bill be now read a second time.

The Road Traffic (Consequential Provisions) Bill 2007 repeals and deletes the various clauses of the Road Traffic Act 1974 that have been moved to the new bills and provides for the amendment of all other legislation impacted upon by these changes. This bill does not introduce any new legislative provisions into Western Australian law, but simply facilitates the new road traffic legislation structure to be introduced in the Road Transport Reform (Compliance and Enforcement) Bill. I commend the bill to the house.
