*Standing Orders Suspension — Motion*

**MR D.A. TEMPLEMAN (Mandurah — Leader of the House)** [12.18 pm]: I move —

That so much of standing orders be suspended as is necessary to enable private members' business to have priority from 4.00 pm to 8.00 pm on Wednesday, 31 October 2018.

Just to speak briefly to that motion, this has been done to accommodate requirements for the member for South Perth, who is the opposition's lead speaker on the cognate bills.
