Question: Dr A.D. Buti asked: What is the total amount of state government funding for curriculum and re-engagement schools?

Answer:

The total amount of funding provided to CARE schools by the Department of Education Services in 2013/14 is \$5,904,987.14. This is inclusive of the base per student grant and the loading specific to CARE school students. A firm estimate of the total funding for 2014/15 is subject to updated enrolment numbers and cost indexation values and will not be known until late 2014.
