

**ARMISTICE CENTENARY**

*Standing Orders Suspension — Notice of Motion*

**Mr D.A. Templeman (Leader of the House)** gave notice that at the next sitting of the house he would move —

That so much of the standing orders be suspended as is necessary to enable, at 11.00 am on Thursday, 8 November 2018, the house to observe one minute's silence in recognition of the centenary of Armistice, and to be followed by the Premier, the Leader of the Opposition and the Leader of the National Party, or a member deputed, to make statements up to a maximum of 15 minutes each commemorating the centenary of the Armistice that ended the First World War, and then any other member to be able to make statements in reply, up to a maximum of five minutes each, and for these statements to have priority until 12.50 pm, unless concluded earlier, or if not concluded at 12.50 pm, to continue after question time until concluded.
