

**APPROPRIATION (CONSOLIDATED ACCOUNT) RECURRENT 2009-10 BILL 2009**

*Receipt and First Reading*

Bill received from the Assembly; and, on motion by **Hon Norman Moore (Leader of the House)**, read a first time.

*Second Reading*

**HON NORMAN MOORE (Mining and Pastoral — Leader of the House)** [10.03 pm]: I move —

That the bill be now read a second time.

The purpose of this bill is to grant supply and to appropriate sums from the consolidated account required for the recurrent services and purposes for the 2009-10 financial year as detailed in the consolidated account agency information in support of the estimates.

Total expenditure is estimated to be \$16 285 906 000, of which \$1 345 558 000 is permanently appropriated under special acts, leaving an amount of \$14 940 348 000, which is to be appropriated to the services and purposes identified in the schedule to this bill.

I commend the bill to the house.
