

Division 54: Commissioner of Main Roads (Except Service 7—Office of Road Safety) —

Question: Mrs M.H. Roberts asked: How much money from the road trauma trust fund will be spent at the intersections of Reid Highway and Malaga Drive; South Street and Kwinana Freeway; Reid Highway and Mitchell Freeway; Ennis Avenue, Elanora Drive and Grange Drive; South Street and Findlay Road; and Albany Highway and Leach Highway?

Answer: The Road Trauma Trust Account will provide \$10.7 million for road safety improvements at these metropolitan intersections.

Question: Mrs M.H. Roberts asked: What percentage of the funding announced for the upgrade of Roe Highway and Berkshire Road in Forrestfield is recurrent spending and what percentage is capital?

Answer: 100 per cent of the funding announced is capital.

Question: Mrs M.H. Roberts asked: Where will the passing lanes be on Albany Highway and how much money has been allocated for them?

Answer: Lanes will be added south of Williams at SLK 189.4 and SLK 19435.

[Supplementary Information No A42.]

Question: Mr D.A. Templeman asked: Has Main Roads advised the City of Mandurah that it will not consider construction of the second estuary bridge until the City of Mandurah funds the four-lane upgrade to the old Mandurah traffic bridge?

Answer: No, Main Roads has not provided such advice.

(Note - Main Roads has provided advice that a second Mandurah Estuary bridge cannot be justified at this time however would likely be required in the future with the timing dependent on development and traffic growth.)

Question: Mr D.A. Templeman requested Main Roads modelling for current and predicted traffic volumes for the old Mandurah traffic bridge and the Mandurah Estuary Bridge?

Answer: The current and predicted traffic volumes on the Mandurah Estuary Bridge and Old Mandurah Traffic Bridge in average vehicles per day (vpd) are as follows:

	Current	2031
Mandurah Estuary Bridge	31,000 vpd	48,000 vpd
Old Mandurah Traffic Bridge	18,000 vpd	34,000 vpd
