

NORTH MANDURAH PRIMARY SCHOOL — INTENSIVE ENGLISH CENTRE

Question without Notice 237 — Answer Advice

MR D.A. TEMPLEMAN (Mandurah) [2.53 pm]: Pursuant to standing order 82A, on 20 May I asked the Minister for Education a question without notice about the North Mandurah Primary School intensive English centre, and the minister informed me that she would answer that question. I mentioned to the minister on Wednesday, 2 June during the estimates committee hearing that I had not received a reply. I am very keen, because of the parents and teachers at that school, to receive a response and I ask whether the minister could indicate when that response will be coming.

The SPEAKER: Once again, member for Mandurah, and also for all members in this place, standing order 82A enables a minister to provide further information. The minister is able to stand in the house and do that. It is not for someone else in this place—in this instance, the member for Mandurah—to ask that. However, if the Minister for Education has some information that she wishes to provide under standing order 82A, I am happy for that process to continue.
