3982. Mr A. Krsticevic to the Minister for Culture and the Arts:

I refer to the answer to Question on Notice No 3415 (1)(c) and a radio frequency identification (RFID) tracking system to be implemented in the Art Gallery of WA artworks collection, and ask:

- (a) What is the start-up costs to implement the RFID system;
- (b) What will be the ongoing costs for the RFID system in each of the years 2019–20 and 2020–21; and
- (c) Which company has supplied the RFID system and where is the business located?

Mr D.A. Templeman replied:

- (a) Total estimated cost \$39,600 for software set-up, testing, commissioning, configuration, training, licences, and database integration.
- (b) \$9,760 per year.
- (c) The Locafi RFID Asset Tracking Solution in partnership with Smarttrack RFID is designed for application to Museum and Art Gallery Collections. The company is based in Sydney and Canberra.
