

LOCAL GOVERNMENT ACT — REVIEW

4211. Mr A. Krsticevic to the Minister for Local Government:

I refer to the consultation period for the second phase of the review into *Local Government Act 1995*, and ask:

- (a) when will the consultation period conclude; and
- (b) when will the Minister reveal the department's recommendations for changes to the Act?

**Mr D.A. Templeman replied:**

- (a) 31 March 2019, a number of discussion papers have been released to encourage people and organisations to contribute to the transformation of the Local Government Act. There are a range of opportunities to provide feedback between now and the end of March 2019, and I encourage anyone with ideas to contribute to take this opportunity to get involved.

All submissions and feedback received through this process will be considered for inclusion in the new Local Government Act.

- (b) The McGowan Government will announce proposed reforms after considering the submissions.
