

TRANSPERTH — TRANSIT OFFICERS

4643. Dr A.D. Buti to the Minister for Transport:

- (1) How many Transperth Transit Officers were on:
 - (a) each train travelling from Armadale Station to Perth Station from 6.00pm to the last departing train on each day from 28 September 2015 to 4 October 2015.;
 - (b) each train travelling from Perth Station to Armadale Station from 6.00pm to the last departing train on each day from 28 September 2015 to 4 October 2015;
 - (c) each train travelling from Thornlie Station to Perth Station from 6.00pm to the last departing train on each day from 28 September 2015 to 4 October 2015.;
 - (d) each train travelling from Perth Station to Thornlie Station from 6.00pm to the last departing train on each day from 28 September 2015 to 4 October 2015;
 - (e) each train travelling from Midland Station to Perth Station from 6.00pm to the last departing train on each day from 28 September 2015 to 4 October 2015;
 - (f) each train travelling from Perth Station to Midland Station from 6.00pm to the last departing train on each day from 28 September 2015 to 4 October 2015;
 - (g) each train travelling from Fremantle Station to Perth Station from 6.00pm to the last departing train on each day from 28 September 2015 to 4 October 2015;
 - (h) each train travelling from Perth Station to Fremantle Station from 6.00pm to the last departing train on each day from 28 September 2015 to 4 October 2015;
 - (i) each train travelling from Mandurah Station to Esplanade Station from 6.00pm to the last departing train on each day from 28 September 2015 to 4 October 2015;
 - (j) each train travelling from Esplanade Station to Mandurah Station from 6.00pm to the last departing train on each day from 28 September 2015 to 4 October 2015;
 - (k) each train travelling from Butler Station to Esplanade Station from 6.00pm to the last departing train on each day from 28 September 2015 to 4 October 2015; and
 - (l) each train travelling from Esplanade Station to Butler Station from 6.00pm to the last departing train on each day from 28 September 2015 to 4 October 2015?
- (2) For any of the above, were there incidences where no Transit Officers were present on the train at any time during the journey?

Mr D.C. Nalder replied:

- (1) (a)–(l) [See tabled paper no 3667.]
- (2) In addition to the services where no T/Os are rostered as mentioned above, there were occasions during the period of 28 September 2015 to 4 October 2015 when T/O and RPO staff were not present on a train service. These were for the following reasons:

29 September 2015 at 9:52pm: T/Os detained at Burswood station (travelling Armadale to Perth) due to a fight on the service and the offenders were refused further travel. T/Os reboarded their next scheduled service to Armadale.

30 September 2015 at 8:30pm: T/Os detained at Burswood station (travelling Armadale to Perth) in order to verify the personal details of an offender. T/Os reboarded their next scheduled service to Armadale.

1 October 2015 at 8:10pm: RPOs detained at Perth station in order to deal with a ticketing offence and as a result, were unable to board their next tabled service to Mandurah.

2 October 2015 at 8:35pm: T/Os detained at Warnbro station (travelling Perth to Mandurah) in order to replace the T/Os at Warnbro station as those officers were required to assist in the transportation of an arrested person to the Perth Watch House. As a result of this incident, T/Os were unable to board their next tabled service to Mandurah.

2 October 2015 at 8:47pm: RPOs detained at Perth station in order to deal with a ticketing offence at the station.

2 October 2015 at 9:02pm: RPOs detained at Perth station due to personal illness and as a result, were unable to board their next tabled service to Armadale.

2 October 2015 at 11:17pm: RPOs detained at Perth station due to personal illness and as a result, were unable to board their next tabled service to Thornlie.

2 October 2015 at 10:34pm: T/Os at Perth station (arriving on a service from the Armadale to Perth) missed a connecting train service due to the late running of that service. As a result, T/Os were unable to board the next tabled service to Armadale.

4 October at 8:52pm: T/Os detained at Warnbro station (travelling Perth to Mandurah) in order deal with a disorderly male on-board the service. T/Os reboarded their next scheduled service to Esplanade/Perth.
