

LAKELANDS ESTATE, MANDURAH — SAFETY

Petition

MR D.A. TEMPLEMAN (Mandurah) [12.30 pm]: I have a petition signed by 424 signatories. It is confirmed that it conforms with the standing orders of the Legislative Assembly and is framed in the following terms —

To the Honourable the Speaker and Members of the Legislative Assembly of the Parliament of Western Australia in Parliament assembled.

We, the undersigned, say

That there is a serious safety concern in Lakelands Estate Mandurah. The intersection of Catalina Drive and Mandurah Road is extremely busy, especially during peak periods and is the only viable entrance and exit for the Lakelands Estate. We are very concerned that this access is becoming increasingly dangerous for our local residents, visitors to the Estate and parents and children accessing Mandurah Baptist College and Lakelands Primary School.

Now we ask the Legislative Assembly

1. *As a matter of urgency request the Minister for Transport to instruct and fund Main Roads to install traffic lights as a means of safely controlling the intersection of Catalina Drive and Mandurah Road in the locality of Lakelands;*
2. *The Minister provide 50% of the funding through Main Roads to ensure the extension of Banksiadale Gate to Mandurah Road and Madora Bay Road Lakelands is constructed which will create another safe access into and out of the locality.*
