

POLICE — FRONTLINE 2020 — MINISTER FOR POLICE'S COMMENTS

**898. Dr A.D. BUTI to the Minister for Police:**

I refer to the minister's comments last month, which read —

As part of the Frontline 2020 reform model, our 24-hour, seven-day-a-week district support teams have trained domestic violence support people who are specialists in family and domestic violence available 24 hours a day, seven days a week, ...

Yet Deputy Police Commissioner Gary Dreiberger, in a letter to the Community Development and Justice Standing Committee, said that the statement is not correct.

- (1) Who is correct, the minister or the deputy police commissioner?
- (2) Will the minister correct the record for once again misleading the house yesterday about broadening the definition of domestic violence relationships?
