

ROADS, EXPENDITURE ON MAINTENANCE

2481. Hon Jim Scott to the Parliamentary Secretary representing the Minister for Planning and Infrastructure
For each of the last five financial years -

- (1) What did Main Roads WA/DPI spend on road and highway maintenance?
- (2) What was that amount as a percentage of each year's total expenditure on roads by MRWA/DPI?
- (3) What was the total amount of money Main Roads WA/DPI allocated to Local Government for the maintenance of roads under Local Government control?

Hon KEN TRAVERS replied:

- (1) The expenditure by Main Roads Western Australia on the maintenance of roads in all networks across the State in each of the last five financial years was as follows:
1999/00 - \$197.4 million
2000/01 - \$229.8 million
2001/02 - \$204.5 million
2002/03 - \$221.4 million
2003/04 - \$217.1 million
- (2) The above amounts expressed as a percentage of the total spend on Roads (excluding Financial and Other Costs such as Road Infrastructure Depreciation and Loan Repayments, etc) by Main Roads Western Australia are as follows:
1999/00 - 28.9%
2000/01 - 31.9%
2001/02 - 36.5%
2002/03 - 42.3%
2003/04 - 40.6%
- (3) The expenditure by Main Roads Western Australia on the maintenance of Local Government Roads in all areas across the State in each of the last five financial years was as follows:
1999/00 - \$55.3 million
2000/01 - \$67.3 million
2001/02 - \$65.0 million
2002/03 - \$56.9 million
2003/04 - \$53.8 million
