

CYBERSECURITY POLICY

82. Hon WILSON TUCKER to the Minister for Innovation and the Digital Economy:

I refer to the Office of Digital Government and the WA government's cyber security policy.

- (1) How many agencies have submitted an implementation plan to DGov?
- (2) How many agencies have yet to submit an implementation plan to DGov; and, of those, have any requested an extension?
- (3) Are any agencies deemed exempt from the requirement to submit an implementation plan?
- (4) Of those agencies that have submitted an implementation plan, has DGov identified any agency that is not compliant with the WA government's cyber security policy?

Hon STEPHEN DAWSON replied:

I thank the honourable member for some notice of the question. Member, as the minister with responsibility for the Office of Digital Government, I provide the following answer.

- (1) All 66 agencies required to submit a plan have done so.
- (2) Not applicable.
- (3) No.
- (4) DGov is still processing the annual implementation reports submitted by agencies to ascertain the current level of compliance.
