SOUTH WEST ROADS — FUNDING

988. Mr M.P. Murray to the Minister for Transport:

I refer to the intersection of Throssell Street and Prinsep Street in the Shire of Collie and ask:

- (a) what funding was budgeted in 2012–2013 for the assessment and placement of traffic management devices at this section of road, and:
 - (i) if applicable, of the budgeted funds, have any been acquitted; and
 - (ii) if no funding was budgeted, why not; and
- (b) is funding proposed for the intersection of Throssell Street and Prinsep Street in the Shire of Collie, in the 2013–2014 Budget, and:
 - (i) if applicable, how much funding has been allocated and over what time frame;
 - (ii) if applicable, of this funding allocation, what specific project will be funded; and
 - (iii) if not, why not?

Mr T.R. Buswell replied:

The Main Roads Western Australia advises:

- (a) Nil
 - (i) Not applicable
 - (ii) Traffic signals are not considered to be necessary or desirable at this location by Main Roads.
- (b) No
 - (i)–(ii) Not applicable
 - (iii) Main Roads has recently met with the Shire of Collie at officer level and will undertake a joint review of Throssell Street through Collie, including this intersection. Any upgrade recommendations resulting from this review will be considered for funding in future budgets.
