**Hon Jim Chown replied:**

The average number of weekday passengers in each financial year was as follows:

To City

- (a) 4 215
- (b) 4 465
- (c) 4 373

From City

- (a) 4 051
- (b) 4 306
- (c) 4 131

These values represent passengers that boarded or alighted in the Perth city centre. Other passengers boarding or alighting along the corridor are not included.

The average number of passengers boarding, alighting or travelling along Charles Street in each financial year is as follows:

- (c) 5 099

From City

- (a) 4 862
- (b) 5 212
- (c) 5 046

Boarded in Corridor
