

METROPOLITAN REGION SCHEME AMENDMENT NO 991/33

11. Hon Jim Scott to the Parliamentary Secretary representing the Minister for Planning and Infrastructure

As compensation for the loss of part of the M91 reserve for the Jervoise Bay Harbour proposal, the Government promised to add 42 hectares to parks and recreation reserves through the South West Omnibus MRS Amendment No. 991/33.

Will the Minister assisting the Minister for Planning and Infrastructure indicate -

- (1) The location(s) of each addition to parks and recreation reserves and their size in MRS Amendment No. 991/33?
- (2) Do any of these represent a similar vegetation association as that lost in M91?
- (3) If so, which one(s)?

Hon G.T. GIFFARD replied:

- (1) Metropolitan Region Schemes (MRS) Amendment No. 991/33 as advertised contained the following Parks and Recreation reservation proposals:
 - i) Proposal 3: 1.39ha near Emplacement Crescent, Hamilton Hill;
 - ii) Proposal 4: 0.49ha near the intersection of North Lake Road and Bibra Drive, Bibra Lake;
 - iii) Proposal 5: 1.14ha on Grassbird Loop, Yangebup;
 - iv) Proposal 7: 8.9ha land on Cockburn Road, Munster;
 - v) Proposal 9: 7.26ha adjoining Polletti Road, Success (Restricted Public Access);
 - vi) Proposal 16: 22.15ha land adjoining the Kwinana Beach foreshore, East Rockingham; and
 - vii) Proposal 23: 0.59ha land at the intersection of Crane and Wright Streets, Henderson.

The total area of these is 42.2ha.

Proposal 7 was deleted from the final version of the amendment due to objections from the Fremantle Port Authority. This left 33.02ha of Parks and Recreation land remaining in the finally approved version of the amendment.

South West Districts Omnibus MRS Amendment No. 4 (finalised) included 4.93ha of additional Parks and Recreation reservation.

Proposed South West Districts Omnibus MRS Amendment No. 5 (recently initiated by the WAPC, but not yet advertised for public submissions) includes 42.13ha of additional Parks and Recreation reservation.

The proposed South Fremantle/Hamilton MRS amendment (public advertising completed, awaiting submission to Parliament) includes 0.79ha of coastal Parks and Recreation reservation.

As a result of submissions received on the Jervoise Bay project, the former government agreed to initiate an MRS amendment to delete the Primary Regional Roads reservation which currently traverses the Beeliar Regional Park, immediately adjacent to the Henderson Industrial Area and Jervoise Bay project. This will add a further 25ha to the Park. This amendment has not yet been initiated but should proceed in the near future in an omnibus amendment with several related road proposals.

- (2) Yes.
- (3) The relevant vegetation association is described as Cottesloe Complex Central South. Proposal 23 includes 0.59ha of this vegetation type.
