MAIN ROADS WA BUDGET, FUEL FRANCHISE LEVY

589. Hon M.J. CRIDDLE to the parliamentary secretary representing the Minister for Planning and Infrastructure:

- (1) How much money is in the Main Roads WA budget as a result of the 8.1c a litre fuel franchise levy imposed by the federal Government?
- (2) Will the national and arterial federal road funding allocation of \$41 million be spent on roads?
- (3) How much money is raised from vehicle registration fees in this budget?

Hon KEN TRAVERS replied:

I thank the member for some notice of this question.

- (1) The commonwealth safety net revenue the replacement state fuel levy arrangements lapsed on 30 June 2000 with the introduction of the goods and services tax.
- (2) Provision for the payment of the untied commonwealth road funds lapsed on 30 June 2000 with the introduction of the goods and services tax.
- (3) The estimated revenue is \$249.556 million.
