## CITY RAIL ROUTE, OPTIONS

## 1466. Hon J.A. SCOTT to the parliamentary secretary representing the Minister for Planning and Infrastructure:

In regard to the city rail route options -

- (1) What is the estimated cost per unit of tunnelling?
- (2) What is the total length of tunnelling required for the
  - (a) William Street option; and the
  - (b) City West option?
- (3) Does the City of Perth have a transport planning strategy for the city area?
- (4) Which of the two city rail route options is best able to be integrated with the City of Perth's transport planning strategies?

## Hon LJILJANNA RAVLICH replied:

- (1)-(2) The minister has not yet received the final report of the Perth City Rail Advisory Committee. As soon as the report has been considered by the Government she will be in a position to respond to the member's questions.
