BP REFINERY, KWINANA

685. Hon J.A. SCOTT to the parliamentary secretary representing the Minister for State Development:

- (1) What are the emergency response arrangements for a major incident at BP Refinery (Kwinana) Pty Ltd?
- (2) What would be the impact on fuel supplies and prices if the refinery were to be put out of action?

Hon KEN TRAVERS replied:

I am advised as follows -

- (1) BP Refinery (Kwinana) Pty Ltd has an emergency response plan, emergency response personnel and equipment in place to deal with emergencies on site. BP also has arrangements in place with the Fire and Emergency Services Authority of Western Australia for assisting with emergency management if required.
- (2) This part of the question would be more properly addressed to the Minister for Energy.
