Mrs M.H. ROBERTS replied:

I have never suggested otherwise. When I released that figure it followed the Leader of the Opposition's release of another figure that he claimed was the correct figure, so I corrected that on radio. No, I had not sought advice beforehand. I did not claim that I had sought advice.

Mrs M.H. ROBERTS: Afterwards, on, I think, Tuesday morning, *The West Australian* ran an article in which reference was made to section 83 of the Police Act. I understand that the commissioner sought advice after that and subsequently gave the advice to me.
