Further to question on notice No. 522 of March 20 2002 can the Minister advise of the process that she intends to follow to fill the position of Chief Executive Officer of the Department of Conservation and Land Management?

Hon KIM CHANCE replied:

The Executive Director, Department of Conservation and Land Management, is a chief executive officer position for the purposes of the Public Sector Management Act 1994. As such, section 45 of that Act outlines the process by which that position can be substantively filled.

The Commissioner for Public Sector Standards conducts the process that results in a recommendation under sections 45(8) and (12) of that Act.
