

RAIL LINES — JOONDALUP AND MANDURAH — DISRUPTION

2972. Hon Ken Travers to the Parliamentary Secretary representing the Minister for Transport:

I refer to the train disruptions to the Mandurah and Joondalup rail lines on 9 April 2015, and I ask:

- (a) what time did the delays first occur;
- (b) why did the weather conditions cause delays;
- (c) when did services resume; and
- (d) how many services were affected?

Hon Jim Chown replied:

- (a) 5.01am
- (b) Weather conditions resulted in very slippery track conditions. Accordingly, Drivers operated railcars with caution which caused delays.
- (c) Services never ceased but were delayed for the reason outlined above.
- (d) 190 services.
