## 823. Hon KEN TRAVERS to the parliamentary secretary representing the Minister for Transport:

I refer to the Minister for Transport's comment on Channel Seven news on 18 August 2014 that the government believes it is a priority that it needs to push east and open up the eastern suburbs.

- (1) What areas does the minister expect will be opened up?
- (2) How many new residents does the minister expect these developments will produce?
- (3) Does the minister expect these new developments will be on greenfield sites or through increased densities?
- (4) How many new jobs does the minister expect these developments will produce?
