

PORT COOGEE CONTAMINATION, REMEDIATION

823. Hon Jim Scott to the Parliamentary Secretary representing the Minister for Planning and Infrastructure

- (1) How much money has been set aside for the remediation of the Port Coogee contamination?
- (2) How many dust monitoring sites will be in operation and who will control them?
- (3) How many noise monitoring sites will be in operation and who will control them?
- (4) What company was granted the contamination remediation contract?
- (5) Has this company any experience in remediating contaminated sites?
- (6) If yes, which ones?

Hon GRAHAM GIFFARD replied:

1. Up to \$4 million has been set aside for remediation of the government land at Port Coogee. This will cover remediation, supervision, landfill, soil analysis, air sampling, dust monitoring and other incidental costs.
2. Two mobile and two stationary dust monitors will be in operation. They are to be controlled by the remediation superintendent, ENV Australia.
3. None, as noise generation at this site is not considered by the Department of Environment to be a significant issue.
