

MINISTERIAL CHANGES - COST OF STATIONERY

2335. Mr P.D. Omodei to the Premier

- (1) Could the Premier advise the breakdown of costs, per Ministry, of how much the Government has spent on changing stationery, including letterheads, business cards, envelopes, calendars, advertisements to advise of new Ministerial appointments, and other such materials, due to Ministerial changes since January 2005.
- (2) Please advise the names of the Members of Parliament involved.

- (1) The cost of changes to stationery, other materials and advertisements associated with the appointment of new Ministers is absorbed within existing budgets. No additional funding was allocated, or has been requested to meet these expenses.
