1745. Mr P.D. Omodei to the Minister for Health

- (1) How many patients were removed from tertiary and non-tertiary waiting lists between -
 - (a) 1 January 1999 to 31 December 2004;
 - (b) 1 January 2000 to 31 December 2005; and
 - (c) 1 January 2001 and 31 December (or nearest available date) 2006?
- (2) How many elective surgery wait-list procedures were undertaken at the privately-managed public hospitals in each of the calendar years -
 - (a) 2002;
 - (b) 2003;
 - (c) 2004;
 - (d) 2005; and
 - (e) 2006?
- (3) How many patients were on the elective surgery waiting lists on 1 January -
 - (a) 2004;
 - (b) 2005; and
 - (c) 2006?
- (4) How many patients were waiting to be assessed to go on to the waiting lists in the past -
 - (a) 12 months; and
 - (b) 24 months?

Mr J.A. McGINTY replied:

(1) "Removals" include admission to hospital for surgery, procedure no longer required, patient non-contactable, change of patient status or database audit. Excludes removals due to transfer to another hospital. The numbers of removals from metropolitan tertiary & non-tertiary public hospital waitlists are:
