

PREMIER — PUBLIC SERVICE APPEAL BOARD

737. Hon NICK GOIRAN to the Leader of the House representing the Premier:

I refer the Premier to the finding of the Public Service Appeal Board on 5 January 2023 in which the commissioner said that Hon Roger Cook “did not do everything he could and should have done to ensure leave entitlements were not abused”.

- (1) Will the Premier commit to do everything he can and should do to ensure leave entitlements are not abused in any office in which he has staff?
- (2) Is the Premier’s current chief of staff the same person as the chief of staff whom the Public Service Appeal Board found had alerted him on 2 March 2020 that staff may not have consistently applied for leave that was being taken?
