I refer to patronage on the Australiad train, and I ask:

- (b) were there any periods during each of 2012–13, 2013–14 and 2014–15 when the *Australind* was not available to provide a twice daily service between Perth and Bunbury; and

 - (iii) what alternative transport options were put in place during the periods of unavailability?
