

BICYCLE NETWORK PLAN — SHENTON PARK TO LOCH STREET LINK

1832. Hon Ken Travers to the Parliamentary Secretary representing the Minister for Transport:

I refer to the Western Australia Bicycle Network Plan and ask, for the priority link Perth to Fremantle Railway Line from Shenton Park to Loch Street:

- (a) what planning work has been done on this link;
- (b) what are the details of the works required;
- (c) when does the Minister expect work to commence;
- (d) when does the Minister expect works to be completed;
- (e) what is the estimated cost of this project; and
- (f) how much is currently allocated in the 2014–15 State Budget and in each year of the forward estimates?

Hon Jim Chown replied:

- (a)–(b) It is proposed to install a Principal Shared Path. Detailed design is nearing completion.
- (c)–(d) Works will commence in early 2015 and be completed by the end of 2015.
- (e) The cost estimate will be finalised after the design has been completed.
- (f) 2014–15 — \$2.59 million
2015–16 — \$3.11 million
