- 251. Mr P.D. Omodei to the Minister for Tourism; Racing and Gaming; Youth; Peel and the South West Will the Minister advise -
 - (a) the total number of insurance claims made through RiskCover by his/her Ministerial office since 17 February 2001; and
 - (b) the category under which each claim fell, including -
 - (i) motor vehicles;
 - (ii) property;
 - (iii) business interruption;
 - (iv) worker's compensation;
 - (v) liability; and
 - (vi) miscellaneous?

Mr M. McGOWAN replied:

- (a) The current Minister for Tourism; Racing and Gaming; Youth; Peel and the South West has only been a Minister from 10 March 2005. During the period from which he was appointed a Minister to the present date there has only been one insurance claim made by his Ministerial Office
- (b) A motor vehicle claim was lodged due to damage incurred to the Minister's car as a result of a branch from a large ghost gum outside of Parliament House falling on his car on 4/5/2005.
