4091. Hon Adele Farina to the parliamentary secretary representing the Minister for Transport:  
In 2015-16, what road improvements were completed in the South West region?

**Hon Jim Chown replied:**

The following Improvements were made on State Roads in the South West Region in 2015/16:

**Bannister Marradong Road**

Widened intersection and widened the adjacent road with sealed shoulders.

**Bussell Highway**

Installed street lighting

Constructed Bypass including a pedestrian underpass.

Widening and reconstruction immediately south of the Bypass.

Provided sealed shoulders and widened bridge to provide a right turn lane

**Caves Road**

Widening to provide sealed shoulders.

**Coalfields Highway**

Realigned highway with sealed shoulders and a wide centre median including upgrading intersection and upgrade of the truck bay A further partially completed realignment will be completed in late 2016 when weather conditions improve.

**Donnybrook Kojonup Road**

Widening to provide sealed shoulders, installed barriers at selected locations and selected clearing of hazardous trees.

Realigned, improved curves and widening Provided sealed shoulders

**Forrest Highway**

Installed street lighting at intersection.

**South Western Highway**

Provided right and left turn lanes at intersections.

Constructed a new bridge including realignment of highway.

Reconstructed and widened the north approach, including a wide median and upgrades to intersections.

Installed additional safety barriers.

Widened a major culvert.

Installed an additional safety barrier.

Widening with sealed shoulders.

**Vasse Highway**

Widening with sealed shoulders.
