  - (a) aerial shoots; and
  - (b) ground shoots?
- (2) What was the total number of personnel involved?
- (3) What number and species of feral animals were culled for each exercise?
- (4) What was the location of the exercise?
- (5) What was the total cost of each shoot?
- (6) What was the total cost for each animal that was culled?
