

LOCAL GOVERNMENT — ROAD FUNDING

547. Hon KEN TRAVERS to the parliamentary secretary representing the Minister for Transport:

I refer to the additional expenditure of \$67 million for local government road projects that was reported in the 2012–13 *Government Mid-year Financial Projections Statement*.

- (1) Which local road projects are included in this expenditure?
- (2) How much money is allocated to each road project in each year of the forward estimates?

Hon JIM CHOWN replied:

- (1) Curtin Avenue realignment; Mandurah traffic bridge; Eaton–Treendale bridge; and Gnangara Road dual carriageway.
- (2) The 2012–13 *Government Mid-year Financial Projections Statement* contained the following allocations: Curtin Avenue realignment, \$27 million; Mandurah traffic bridge, \$5.7 million; Eaton–Treendale bridge, \$2 million; and Gnangara Road dual carriageway, \$13 million.
